What is an I-94?

- Evidence of your admission to and legal status in the US
- Evidence of registration with US government
- Shows your **legal status** (F-1 or J-1, or F-2 and J-2 dependents) and **expiration date**
- You will **receive a new I-94 record** every time you leave and re-enter the US
- You cannot remain in the US past the expiration date unless you file an 'extension of stay' application with USCIS

Visiting the U.S. & Arriving Via a Land Border or Selected Ferry?

A Form I-94 is needed by all visitors except: U.S. Citizens, returning resident aliens, aliens with immigrant visas, and most Canadian citizens visiting or in transit. Travelers will be issued an I-94 during the admission process at the port of entry. If you are traveling via a land border or by ferry from selected ports, you may apply for a provisional I-94 in advance here, saving time while at the port of entry later. If you are a crew member in need of an I-95, one will be issued at the time of arrival.

Already Visiting & Need Visitor Status?

A traveler lawfully admitted (or paroled) into the U.S. may retrieve their most recent I-94/I-95 back to 1983 for admission (or parole) for certain classes of admission and those admitted under Compacts of Free Association. Crewmembers may retrieve their most recent, unexpired I-94/I-95 form. The corresponding I-95 may then be printed and considered your legal admission.

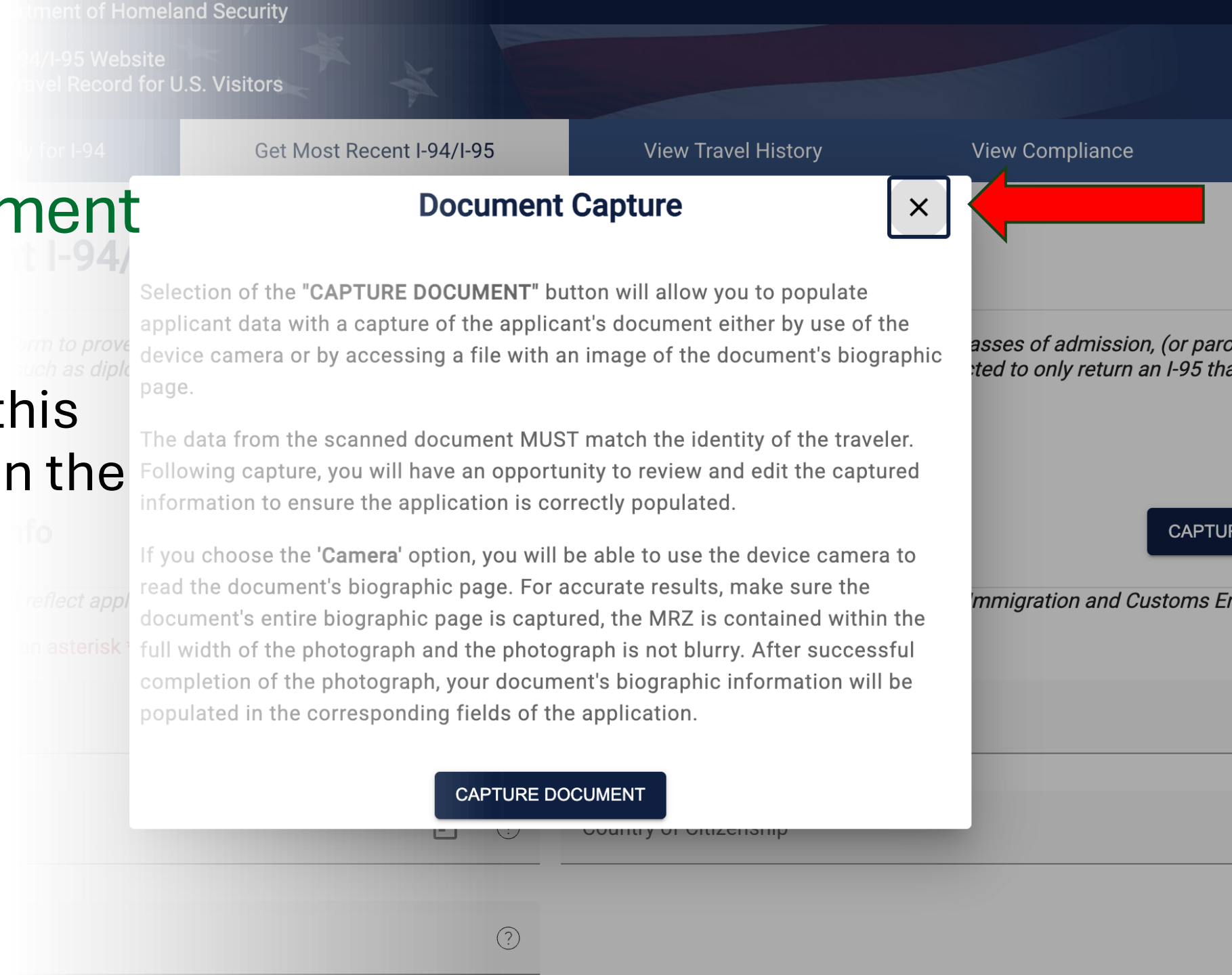

Step 3: Document capture

You can ignore this step and click on the 'X' to close the window



Document Capture



Selection of the "CAPTURE DOCUMENT" button will allow you to populate applicant data with a capture of the applicant's document either by use of the device camera or by accessing a file with an image of the document's biographic page.

The data from the scanned document MUST match the identity of the traveler. Following capture, you will have an opportunity to review and edit the captured information to ensure the application is correctly populated.

If you choose the 'Camera' option, you will be able to use the device camera to read the document's biographic page. For accurate results, make sure the document's entire biographic page is captured, the MRZ is contained within the full width of the photograph and the photograph is not blurry. After successful completion of the photograph, your document's biographic information will be populated in the corresponding fields of the application.
