#### Leaving U.S. for summer term

classes-be-taught-remotely

If you plan to leave the U.S. for summer term and take your summer term classes from your home country, you need to notify ISSS of your departure because of your visa status. Please submit the "Temporary Leave from U.S. Request" eform at <a href="iconnect.uoregon.edu">iconnect.uoregon.edu</a>. Provide your departure date and expected return date and whether you will remain enrolled in summer classes or not.

#### Returning to the U.S.

Unless ISSS has notified you individually that your SEVIS record has been terminated, your I-20 (F1 students) or DS-2019 (J1 students) is still active for re-entry to the U.S. You may return to the U.S. at any time once travel and visa services have resumed. Please make sure your visa is valid and you have a valid travel signature on your I-20 or DS-2019.

#### Delays in dropping classes and complete withdrawals

The Office of the Registrar is experiencing a high volume of requests to drop classes (partial and complete withdrawal), add classes and process other petitions. We know this is frustrating. If you have been in touch with an ISSS advisor who has confirmed that we have approved a request you have made, please just be patient. The Office of the Registrar will not penalize students whose requests were submitted and were approved by ISSS.

#### IRS deposits/checks for \$1200

If you received a \$1,200 check or bank deposit from the IRS, do NOT spend this money until you verify with the ISSS office whether you are eligible to keep this money or not. You may have received the payment mistakenly if you do not meet the IRS definition of "resident alien" and incorrectly filed Form 1040 instead of 1040NR or NR-EZ.
