Leaving the U.S. for Summer Term

Remote instruction will continue through the 2020 summer term. If you are in the U.S. and plan to leave to take summer term from your home country, you need to notify ISSS of your departure. Please submit the "Temporary Leave from U.S. Request" eform at iconnect.uoregon.edu. Provide your departure date and expected return date and whether you plan to enroll in summer courses or not.

Grading Options EXTENDED to July 16th for Spring Term 2020

The Office of the Registrar has extended the deadline to change grade options to graded or to pass/no pass to July 16th! This means that if you fail a graded course spring term, you can still change the grade option to P/NP up until July 16th. Likewise, if you passed a course which you took P/NP, you can change the grade option to graded to enhance your overall GPA. See <u>Academic Calendar Spring 2020</u>.

Proposed Recommendations to Suspend OPT

ISSS is fully aware of recent recommendations proposed to the Department of Homeland Security and the White House to suspend the OPT program for international students. Optional Practical Training (OPT)

If you are graduating spring or summer term and want to apply for OPT work authorization to extend your F1 status for 12 months, now is the time to apply! Here are the steps to take: 1) attend a <u>Zoom OPT workshop</u>; 2) download the <u>OPT application packet</u>; 3) schedule a remote OPT advising session with an ISSS advisor by calling 541-346-3206.
